Since 2005, on behalf of CHILD SURGERY - Viet Nam Foundation, 15 projects for surgery on physically handicapped children have been completed in remote areas. Over 1200 children have benefited from this work already. Nowadays there is special attention for enhancement of the skills of the local surgeons in remote areas. In the Revalidation Center of Thay Nguyen there is a strong focus on burn treatment.

The Revalidation Centre of Thay Nguyen serves people from Thay Nguyen province and some of the surrounding provinces, an area with about 2 million people. Thousands of them are physically handicapped.

Sub Section: What Is The Problem?

[67] Definition

Poor people cannot reach medical help because of a lack of finance. This problem is largest if the cure has to be given in the capital city Hanoi. The Revalidation centre of Thay Nguyen can give treatment on a medium scale.

Sub Section: What Caused The Problem?

[66] Analysis

The problem is lack of money. Fewer patients are able to come in for treatment. Severe handicaps cannot be treated at all. Such children will be left in their situation for a long time.

Sub Section: What Is This Project Going To Do About The Problem?

[69] Activities

There has been a pilot project recently to find out if local surgeons are able to receive additional training for relatively simple procedures. The surgeons were enthusiastic and this process is planned for the coming years. Special focus is given for skin burn treatment. Extra funds are needed.

Sub Section: What Are The Concrete Goals Of This Project?

In the near future, the surgeons will be able to perform more difficult operations. Patients do not have to be sent to Hanoi. The amount of work the surgeons do increases and the facilities will be used more efficiently.

Four surgeons have raised their skills for diagnostic and treatment. They can pass it on to new incoming surgeons.
