The children formerly living and working on the dumpsite of Sihanoukville are now given a new shelter in the Sareka-House, a project initiated by Stichting Wees Welkom. The children never have seen a dentist in their live and therefore their teeth are in a bad shape. We already provided them with toothbrushes and hygiene-education, but the damage done can only be repaired by a dentist.

If we receive enough money we will take the children one by one to the dentist who will then bring their teeth back into a good shape. We already have provided toothbrushes and toothpaste and thought the children how and when to use it.
