In the proposed target regions 112 HIV/AIDS infected children are identified and most of them are living with single parents or guardians who are not afford to give children their basic needs. Most of their parents are disoriented and do not bother about their children's needs. These children are lacking proper means to grow and develop their skills. They don't get proper food to eat and clothes to wear. Their school needs are denied and they get dropped out from school. Since their medical needs are not properly attended these children become quick victims of this deadly disease. These children are also face social discrimination and stigma in the society. These children are in difficult circumstances and we have to extend them a helping hand. Give them a smile to smile.

Sub Section: What Is The Problem?

No of HIV and AIDS children in India are increasing day by day and these children are neglected and their rights of opportunities are denied by their family members or care takers. These children are not responsible for what they are but their needs have been abandoned and their development needs are not taken care. They lack basic necessities such as food, clothes, shelter, education, health and parental support and care. The parents are not showing much interest in the development of their children as they have been already traumatized by their infection. The guardians are treating the children as burden in the family. These children struggle for survival and lead very unpleasant lives. Through this project we intend to give these children a chance of happy living. We would like to care for their needs and help them to develop their career through good education. We wish to give these disadvantaged children a happy childhood.

Sub Section: What Caused The Problem?

[66] Problem analysis

HIV and AIDS infection weakens the hope of survival and living. Many HIV and AIDS parents having lost their hope of survival fail to fulfill their own needs and the needs of their children who are also infected with HIV and AIDS. The parents come to the decision that their lives and their children's lives are destined and they all would die after a period of time. So they do not show much interest in their lives and in the development of their children. They prolong their lives expecting the fatal death and do not bother about their children who need care, love and attention. Those children under the custody of their guardians also suffer due to lack of care and attention. Many cases the guardians are not interested in the development of such children and unwilling to make any expense for their development. In general, these children do not get good food to eat, they do not get good clothes to wear and they are not offered good education and proper medical care and parental care and attention, but as children they have rights to receive all these without fail. The basic rights of HIV and AIDS children to participation and development are denied and through this project we want to ensure these children their rights of development and participation.

The secondary potential threat to the project is the social stigma on HIV and AIDS persons. When people identify the particular person or child is infected with HIV/AIDS they keep distance and avoid them. People term them as bad persons or child from the bad family. So we will maintain certain level of secrecy and simultaneously motivate and educate the communities to accept and treat the HIV/AIDS persons as equal and normal people in the society. For this purpose DEET will organize several awareness camps and education programs from its own resources.

(17.04.1999) Mother :Vijayarani, HIV Positive Father : Suresh, HIV Positive Name of the Village :Chettinayackanpatty. Family Situation The father of Nagananthini has two wives. Nagananthini's mother lives on her own. Nagananthini's mother is infected with HIV +Ve. Nagananthini has two younger brothers. These two of them were treated specially in order to avoid infection. So they were escaped from the disease and now they grow healthy. Support The neighborhood knows that Nagananthini's mother is infected with HIV +Ve. Therefore the family faces a lot of discrimination in the village. The village speaks ill about Nagananthini's mother. Education Nagananthini's mother is finding to bring up and educate her three children. The Children very much feel the absence of their father and because of this the education of the children suffers much. Economic Situation Since the family is separated from the father, the source of income is very less. It is Nagananthini's mother who goes for work occasionally as coolie. Since they have no source of income, the family is finding it difficult to cope with the ill health and the education of the children. They live in total poverty worried about the next day always. 2. Name of the Child:Youvetha Sex Female Age 6 Years Father's Name Mr.Prabhu Mother's Name Mrs. Pandiammal Caste Backward Class Standard in which the child is studying = 1st Std Health condition of the child HIV Infected Brief History of the Child: Youvetha is the only daughter to Mr.Prabhu and Mrs. Pandiammal couple. Mr. Prabhu was a Tractor Driver. During agricultural season he used to stay months together outside the village and work. Once in three months he used to return to home spent one or two weeks with his family. He got infected and died of HIV when Youvetha was 2 years old. As they belong to backward community the village people separated them from the village. Due to social stigma Mrs. Pandiammal was forced to go out of the village and stayed for 2 years. As she is also infected by HIV, she could not stay alone and work. She approached her parents and convinced them to stay with them with her daughter Youvetha. Now Youvetha and her mother Pandiammal are living with her grandparents. The grandparents and the mother of Youvetha are all working in the agricultural field and earning very little money and living in the village. None of her relatives are helping this family. Youvetha is very pleasing character. She is intelligent and good in her studies. She is highly appreciated by everybody for her talents particularly in dancing. She is a bright student in the school. She wanted to become a lawyer.
