This project targets the 60 unskilled and unemployed youths in Karu community and the entire Karu community. These youths were identified during IFEHS meeting with the community men and women folk. Find attached the picture of the community men and women folk.

### **Sub Section: What Is The Problem?**

[67] Problem definition

IFEHS has been working in Karu community to address several issues affecting the community due to its vulnerability. IFEHS met with the women and men folk of the community for need assessment and one of the community's concern is high level of their unemployed youths. 25 out of 60 of these youths want to learn tailoring with bakery and knitting, 15 want to learn hair making while 20 want to learn furniture making. Out of these, IFEHS has trained 6 of the youths in hair making and they have been employed by beauty institutions. Also, IFEHS has identified tailoring outfits that will employ 20 of the youths when they finish learning. So in this project, IFEHS want to train the youths and also equip a learning centre for tailoring and hair making so that some of the youths that are not employed will make use of the learning centre and continue to raise money for them selves and train other youths as identified. IFEHS will continue to source for fund to train the 15 youths that want to learn furniture making and buy equipments for them

### **Sub Section: What Caused The Problem?**

[66] Problem analysis

The problem is unemployment because of lack of skills. About 60 youths in Karu community are not employed because they do not have skills to be employed by companies. This keeps the youths idle at business hours. IFEHS paid 1,500Euros to train 6 youths in hair making and all of them have been employed and we still have 9 youths that want to learn hair making. If IFEHS has equipments, we could keep back 2 to train the remaining 9 free. IFEHS had budget of 200,000Euros last year because we already have a budget of 180,000Euros from USAID for a Sesame street program that we are doing. So IFEHS sourced for the 20,000 Euros out of which we used 1,500Euros to train the youths in hair making. We believe that if we have equipments, it will be easier to employ skilled personnel's to train people and get them employed while we keep some back to keep training others and make money for themselves.
