Poor Dalit people denied of opportunities equal participation and in decision making. They are not availed with proper housing for habitation.

Even if they get rare helps to put houses and contractors used low standard or substandard materials. Because they are voiceless. Now there are 44 houses in a Dalit village about to fall and not fit for habitation anymore. The family members are moved and living in temporary shelters or relatives houses.

The local people are going to take up the project themselves to built new houses. REEDS will extend training support to built houses. The village women will be trained in brick making and will involve in construction of their own houses. They will become expert in construction and carpentry trades as well.

Some Jesuit Priest who associate with REEDS contacted for a help to rebuild dilapiated houses in the Village called Dasarapatty Pudukottai. REEDS assured them doing any help to the village people after a proper case study to find out the real situation that demands rebuilding the houses. Accordingly REEDS together with Mr.Cornelis Rijken along with his Italian friend visited the village and assessed the real needs of the Dalit community. Later an Italian Civil Engineer who visited REEDS has been consulted and got his ideas and suggestions to rebuild the houses. Recently due to heavy rain in the village the old houses further damaged and almost to collapse or falldown. Now the 42 families really in need of safe house. REEDS is in constant touch with women group members in the village and organised meeting to make them aware of their own participation in the project. And the women members realized themselves to take training on eco-friendly quality bricklaying to rebuild for their own houses with quality material applications.
